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## **MORNING NOTES**

**Reading/Language Arts-** Next week we will wrap up Unit 2. We will do some fun Thanksgiving activities involving literacy skills. The following week we will begin Unit 3 with books about weather.

<u>K-Wac (phonics)</u>— There will be no letter of the week Nov. 25-27. After Thanksgiving your child should bring a **K** item (Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>).

**Spelling & Writing-**The next test is Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>. Please practice the first four words in a different order each time so your child produces the sounds & writes the corresponding letters (rather than simply memorizing). The sentence should include the uppercase letter, period, and spacing between words.
