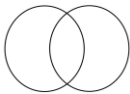

Reading/Language Arts- We tasted seaweed after reading *A Home for Hermit Crab*! ☺ Soon we will read about pond life.



We will compare animal stories using a venn diagram. We will also begin blending sounds together into short words, such as *pat*, *tap*, *cap*, & *cat*.
